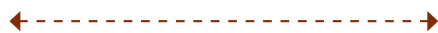


Rest day

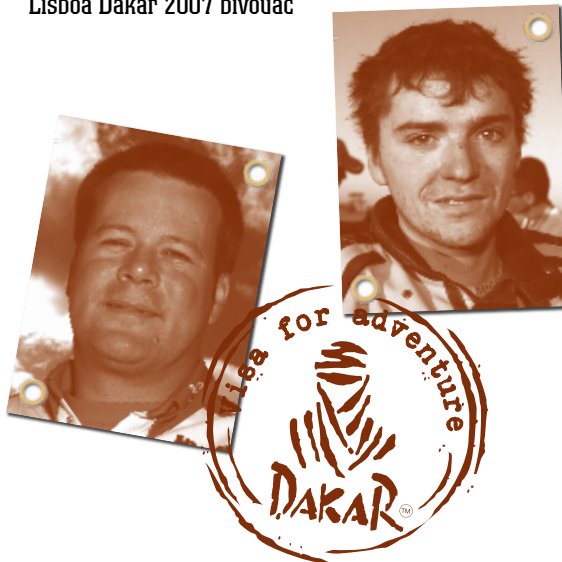

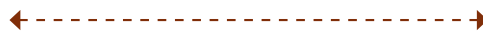
Friday 12th January 2007
