FEES FOR ASSISTANCE VEHICLES

**Amateurs are vehicles not belonging to an official or semi-official team.

Note: Any failure to pay will automatically result in disqualification from the Dakar rally for the next five years.

THESE FEES INCLUDE

- Return boat trip for the vehicles from Europe to Buenos Aires and from Buenos Aires to Europe (the shipping and unloading port in Europe will be announced later)
- Sporting charges
- Medical assistance
- Food and beverages at the bivouacs Insurance, which includes civil liability motor insurance valid along the entire route as well as medical repatriation insurance
- GPS rental

THESE FEES DO NOT INCLUDE

- E-track rental
- VHF radio rental
- Visa charges (mandatory)
- Satellite telephone
- Fuel
- Vehicle repatriation to Buenos Aires if withdrawn from the race
- Travel costs

** The trucks with length between 9 and 11 meters will have to pay an additional fee of 500 €, those with length between 11 and 13 meters, an additional fee of 1.000 €. Beyond 13 meters, please get in touch with the organization.
